## **Easter Grace Fanfare**

For Brass Quintet







Easter Grace Fanfare combines several beloved church hymns, all but one of which come from the celebration of Easter. "Amazing Grace" starts in the low brass and is interrupted repeatedly as the trumpets provide fanfares based on various Easter hymns. The piece culminates with all brass joining together on the final phrase of "Christ the Lord is Risen Today."

Easter Grace Fanfare could be played as a fanfare at the start of an Easter service or spring time recital, or it could be used as an extended introduction to the congregational singing of "Christ the Lord is Risen Today."

Effective staging might include seating the low brass toward center of stage or altar area and having trumpets stand at a distance on either side.
